

### **Jeanne O'Neill Scholarship Fund**

A scholarship fund in memory of Jeanne O'Neill, a 1973 graduate of Bishop England, has been established to provide financial assistance for BEHS students

During her four years at Bishop England, Jeanne had an outstanding academic record, was active in Student Government and the Latin and Spanish Clubs, and lettered in tennis. Her outside activities included teaching horseback riding and riding in horse shows. Her brothers Frank, Michael, Steve and Tom and sisters Trish and Mary also graduated from BEHS.

After leaving Bishop England, Jeanne attended the College of Charleston, graduating in 1977. She moved to Washington, DC, working as an economist for the federal government until 1986. She received a law degree from Catholic University in 1982 and an advanced degree in taxation from Georgetown University in 1986. She married Robert Parker in 1989.

Ms. O'Neill was an attorney in private practice from 1986 to 1995 when she joined the Bureau of National Affairs, a legal publishing company. She was an assistant managing editor at the time of her death from multiple myeloma in 2007.

Jeanne was very much appreciative of the education she received at Bishop England and wanted to help others in need of financial assistance.
