

BEHS PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Only Bishop England High School students who have submitted the Parking Application and have received an official BEHS decal are allowed to drive to school.
- **The Bishop England High School parking sticker for the current year must be permanently affixed to the registered vehicle on the OUTSIDE of the back left window or on the back left bumper and be completely visible. They may not be applied to a magnet or taped to the car. Unauthorized vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.**
- Cars should be locked at all times. Bishop England High School does not assume responsibility for contents left in a car or damages to a car.
- Cars may not be backed into parking spaces.
- Cars can only be accessed for the purpose of leaving campus. Seniors may not go to their cars during their free periods. The only exception to this is for a senior who is free last period of the day – in this case, seniors may return to their cars to leave campus, but they may not return to the parking lot until 3:15pm.
- Driving irresponsibly, playing loud music, and all other inappropriate behavior is not permitted in the BEHS parking lot. The Charleston City Police Department has jurisdiction over the BEHS parking lots. As members of the Daniel Island community, we strive to be good neighbors.
- Cars and parking spaces are considered part of the student's property on campus and as such are subject to being searched by the administration.
- Students must enter and exit the parking lots according to the established routes designated by signage on campus.
- If an unauthorized car is parked in a student's space, that car's make and model should be reported to the school office immediately.
- All vehicles that are authorized to park on campus must be free of all offensive or controversial materials (stickers, license plates, decorations, etc.).
- Trash must not be left in the parking lot. All spaces must be kept clean.

- Students are expected to follow the rules of the road and observe good judgment. Traffic violations and improper driving may result in the suspension of parking privileges as well as disciplinary consequences.
- A student may not give another person permission to park in his/her space during school hours. A student may not give his/her space to another person upon leaving BEHS.
- If a student drives to school in a car other than the one registered, he/she must notify the office immediately and complete the appropriate paperwork.
- Students must remain in their assigned spaces until all their riders are in the car. Students may not pick up other students after leaving their assigned spot. Students must wait until after 3:15pm to move their cars from their assigned space to any other area of the campus.
- No student is permitted to park anywhere off campus. This includes surrounding streets and parking lots.
- Students are not permitted to drive mopeds, scooters, golf carts, LSVs, or motorcycles to school.
- Parking privileges may be suspended for violating any of the above rules. No refunds will be given.
